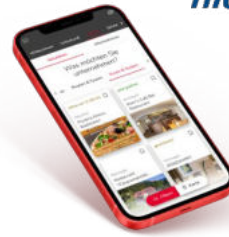

The three summer mountain railways at Nassfeld make the Carnic Alps easily accessible for holidaymakers and day guests during the summer. The Millennium Express, the Gartnerkofel and Madritschen chair lifts take you to Carinthia's incomparable mountain world in just a few minutes. The pleasant mountain air and the panorama of the surrounding massifs transport body and soul into another world.

Millennium-Express

The Millennium Express takes its passengers quickly and comfortably from Tröpolach to Nassfeld. The lift reaches the Tressdorfer Alm and the Madritsche mountain station, among others. The transport of prams and mountain bikes is possible with a valid lift ticket.

Barrier-free access to the mountain railway

should not deprive anyone of the dreamlike panorama at Nassfeld! The mountain railway staff are also happy to help you get on and off and will reduce the speed of the cable car if you wish. Good to know: In addition to the mountain railway, the entire mobility network of the region is barrier-free accessible, including the S-Bahn, the train station as well as the buses in the region..

Signposted disabled parking spaces in the towns of the region, at Lake Pressegg, at Nassfeld and at numerous excursion destinations in the World of Mountains & Lakes.



ENCOUNTERING COWS ON ALPINE PASTURES

TIP: Correct behaviour when encountering cows – for a pleasant hiking experience in any situation.

- ▶ Do not leave hiking trails on alpine pastures!
- ▶ Please keep your dog under control and on a leash!
- ▶ Walk calmly and without attracting attention past the animals in safe distance (20 - 50 meters)..
- ▶ Do not startle the animals and do not look the animals directly in the eyes.
- ▶ Leave the animals alone and do not touch them. Never touch calves!
- ▶ Watch out for threatening gestures of the animals: lowering the head, pawing the ground, lowering, snorting.
- ▶ When the animals approach: keep calm, don't turn your back and leave the alpine pasture slowly!
- ▶ Take your dog off the leash immediately when an attack by an animal is imminent.
- ▶ Don't wave around with the stick. In an abso lute emergency, strike the cow's nose with a stick.

Rules for correct behaviour on the MOUNTAIN!

Whether alone or in a group, with family or friends: Hiking, mountaineering, climbing, via ferrata and mountain biking are among the most popular leisure activities in the Alps. However, every tour is fraught with danger - especially if it is poorly planned or not planned at all.

To ensure that you are always safe on the mountain, we have summarised the most important rules of conduct for you.

The HIKE WORLD for pleasure-seekers

Die The sparkling waves of the water before your eyes. The gentle rustling of the reeds in your ear. Just a handful of anglers nearby that seem to radiate a sense of calm. And behind this wonderful scene, the sun slowly sets in beautiful shades of red and purple ... That's exactly what you're longing for – pure pleasure? Besides the Slow Trail at Lake Presseggersee, many other hiking routes invite visitors to enjoy moments of pure pleasure in the World of Mountains & Lakes..

SLOW TRAIL PRESSEGGER SEE – A relaxing walk through the reeds

The first view is up to the mountains, whose peaks rise steeply into the sky. It is the Gailtal and Carnic Alps that protectively frame Lake Pressegger here.

The dense reed belt only opens up a narrow path. A great crested grebe is spotted among the tall stalks. Its grey plumage shimmers in the sun. You watch him for a while and continue on your way. Up to the steep slope of the bank, from where you can see the typical Carnic mountain peaks with the Nassfeld. On the glistening water, an old boathouse balances...

starting point: Strandbad Hermagor
route: 6 km

level: easy
walking time: about 1,5 hours

SLOW TRAIL WEISSENSEE

Turquoise blue, the lake nestles on the shore, where nothing obscures the view. Two fish float in the clear water. They stand out like shadows against the light background. The lake is said to be the source of the name "Weissensee". The colour of the lake accompanies your steps. Again and again it flashes out between the tall trees. Then, in the Tschölankofel bay, you can finally see the whole lake. The clouds are reflected in its smooth water. Further out, a ship glides towards the eastern shore. Silently it makes its way. Later it will take me back to the starting point. But there is still a lot of time until then. An infinite amount of time.

Starting point: Ronacherfelsen
route: 6,45 km

level: middle
walking time: about 2,5 hours

High up in the family network: Three summer mountain railways, which have been awarded as particularly family-friendly, bring you a great deal closer to pure hiking happiness directly at Nassfeld. This way you can spare your children the strenuous ascent and still enjoy wonderful panoramic views of the Carnic and Gailtal Alps.

Aqua Trail „BergWasser“

Play and marvel along the adventure trail suitable for prams, which brings young and old closer to nature at every step! On a length of 1.5 km, you not only experience the fascinating mountain world, a lake and numerous adventure stations. You learn about the element of water in a playful way, dedicate yourself to building a dam or examine a real sailing boat at 1,900 m above sea level.

Via Dolce Vita

The "Via Dolce Vita" is an extension of the Aqua Trail, a real transport back with panoramic loungers, visholos to explore the distance and - surprise, surprise - Italian Vespas as photo motifs. A playground that looks like a former customs station and limitless swinging fun.

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Madritschen Tour

The stone people of the Madritschen need your help! On the Madritschen tour you will experience an adventurous hike in the Carinthian mountains. There are tricky tests to solve, and you have to be creative and clever. A mighty stone awaits you at the end of the trail, which, with the right twist, will free the ancient stone people.

Lake round trip Pressegger See

From the lido in Hermagor or from the lido in Presseggen, set off on this popular family hike around Lake Presseggen.

Hiking rout through the Weissensee Südufers (von Techendorf in Richtung Naggl)

Together with your loved ones, you will get to know the legends of Lake Weissensee along the Märchenuferweg. Return by boat!

Die Wulfenia (Wulfenia carinthiaca)

All those interested in mountain flowers and botany can expect a natural spectacle in mid-June! The blue-flowered miracle flower of Carinthia is strictly protected and only grows in this subspecies are only known in the Himalayas and Albania. The growing area is located at the foot of the Gartnerkofel (Watschiger Alm area) and can be easily reached in about half an hour's hike from the border crossing at the Sonnenalpe Nassfeld.

BY THE WAY: The name Wulfenia can be traced back to the discoverer, Franz Xaver Freiherr von Wulfen, who discovered this "new blue plant, which no botanist has ever seen and described" in 1779 in the area of the Gartnerkofel - in the area of the Watschiger Alm. and described", in the area of the Gartnerkofel - in the area of the Watschiger Alm.

Geopark Karnische Alpen

In the Nassfeld-Presegger See habitat, it is above all the diverse geology that contributes to the boundless hiking pleasure. Lush meadows, cultivated alpine pastures in Carinthia and Italy, wide valleys and crystal-clear lakes - traces of exciting geological history can be found everywhere. For example, in the Carnic Alps GeoPark, from which you can marvel at the Carnic Alps as well as the Gailtal Alps.

Long-distance hiking is the ideal opportunity for you to become one with nature and enjoy the mountain world to the full? Then the World of Mountains & Lakes is the destination of your choice.

What are the most beautiful tours for multi-day hikes? What do you need to bear in mind on a long-distance hike and what equipment do you need? Find out all about it now::

Karnischer Höhenweg - The Peace Trail of the Carnic Alps

On the Carnic High Altitude Trail (KHW 403) you can immerse yourself in a world far away from the stresses of everyday life. The long-distance hike along the "Peace Trail" of the Carnic Alps is considered one of the most beautiful long-distance hikes in Europe - whether you are a hiker, climber, geologist or nature lover. The 150 km long hiking trail along the ridge of the Carnic Alps has highlights for every taste. From Sillian in East Tyrol to Thörl-Maglern in the lower Gailtal valley, the breathtakingly beautiful high-altitude trail runs along the state border between Austria and Italy.

Gailtaler Höhenweg

Between the Carnic Alps in the south and the Drau Valley in the north, they tower above the valley, the Gailtal Alps. High up on their ridge, the 90-kilometre-long Gailtaler Höhenweg (No. 229) winds its way from Kartitsch in East Tyrol to the Windische Höhe and invites you to explore the most beautiful places of the mountain massif.

The Gailtaler Höhenweg is made for individualists and can be divided into daily stages of any length. The respective ascents and descents are well marked and signposted. You do not need to expect difficult passages on this trail - except for a few more demanding summit crossings. Der

TOURENTIPS:

► The KING Route „Nassfeld Pramollo Hero“

From the valley station of the Millennium Express in Tröpolach, the route first goes uphill along the asphalt road until you change to the gravel road at an altitude of about 950 metres. Follow this road further uphill. In the area of the Rudnig Alm, which you leave on the right, you descend for about 60 metres before the final ascent to Madritsche begins. The Nassfeld Pramollo Hero now goes down the single trail "easy way" to the Nassfeldpass and from here follows the HP6 route via the Garnitzenalm back to the Nassfeldpass. Now you change to route HP5, which you follow until shortly after the Rossalm, before it goes steeply uphill to the mountain station of the Madritsche. This is where the final descent on the HP7 tour begins (60 metres uphill), which is the same in the upper section as the first ascent. From the middle station at 1,000 m above sea level, you can then switch to the "MEX-Line I" flow trail and return to the starting point in Tröpolach with lots of fun..

Crystal clear and emerald green

Crystal clear, deep blue, the mountain lakes in the World of Lakes are breathtakingly beautiful and a real feast for the eyes. Jumping into the ice-cold water is usually too much of a good thing. Overheated hiking feet, on the other hand, are happy about a cool refreshment in summer.

Lago di Pramollo

Originally, the idyllically situated mountain lake on the Austrian-Italian border was a moorland at 1,500 metres above sea level. Today's lake lies between pastures, forests and countless mountain peaks. A beautiful hiking trail leads once around it. In winter, Lago di Pramollo is transformed into a circular cross-country skiing trail.

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Zollner See

Are you in the Gailtal valley on foot or by bike in the direction of the Italian border? Then pay a visit to the Zollner See! The idyllic mountain lake is located in the west of Nassfeld and can be reached on foot by good hikers. The Zollnersee hut, the geotrail and the proximity to Italy make the lake a popular destination.

Wolayer See

The mountain lake, including the hut of the same name, lies at 1,960 metres above sea level and is a true natural jewel located directly on the Carnic High Trail. From Kötschach-Mauthen (in the direction of Plöckenpass) via Valentintal or from Lesachtal with a stop at the Hubertus Chapel, the trail leads to the mountain lake. From the Italian side (start Plöckenpass), the natural jewel can be reached via the Rifugio Marinelli.

Grünsee

Near the Plöcken Pass you will find the quietly situated mountain lake. Well-signposted tours lead hikers around the lake, which owes its name to its deep green colour. It looks like a green emerald. Minerals dissolved in the water are responsible for this beautiful colour effect. A unique sight that you should see with your own eyes!

Bodensee

Directly on the Nassfeldstraße and about ten minutes further to the east right next to the road are the large and small Bodensee lakes. A visit to the large lake is definitely worthwhile here! If only to take home a snapshot of the emerald green natural wonders dotted with many tree trunks.
